<u>APPHON/ROHPPA</u> pharmacy and nursing information on BPMH/medication reconciliation:

For each child treated at your hospital BPMH/medication ask that a reconciliation is completed by your staff and shared with the onsite pharmacists ensure safe administration chemotherapy. Although the chemotherapy orders are generated and directed from the pediatric oncologist at the tertiary center the supportive care medications are prescribed by various practitioners in the care of each child.

As medications may be prescribed for a child by any practitioner it is important to ensure all medications are reviewed by an onsite pharmacist for potential interaction with the chemotherapy prior to administration each visit.
